

OLD YOU or NEW YOU
Pastor Mark Wilks, EPHESIANS 4:17-24

¹⁷ Now this I say and **testify in the Lord**, that you must **no longer walk** as the Gentiles do, in the **futility of their minds**. ¹⁸ They are **darkened in their understanding, alienated** from the life of God because of the **ignorance** that is in them, due to **their hardness of heart**. ¹⁹ They have become **callous** and have given themselves up to **sensuality, greedy to practice every kind of impurity**. ²⁰ But that is not the way you learned Christ! — ²¹ assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus, ²² to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires, ²³ and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, ²⁴ and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness. Your inside and outside must match!

1. Say, “Good-bye to You.”

- We were aimless in our minds.
- We were sightless, because of our hard heart.
- We were insensitive, only focused on what we craved.

2. Becoming the New YOU.

- Put off the OLD YOU - this is a process.
- You have to start thinking differently.
- Put on the new self – the new you reflects Jesus in you.
