Honor Your Father and Mother

ESV 6 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ² "Honor your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), ³ "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land." ⁴ Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord. Ephesians 6:1-4

NIV 6 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ² "Honor your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise— ³ "that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."

⁴ Fathers, <u>do not exasperate your children</u>; instead, <u>bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord</u>.

1. Why should I obey my parents?

- Three reasons we are called to obey.
 - a) It's "right" meaning it is the <u>natural law</u>.
 - b) It's the Law of God.
 - c) It comes with a promise.
- The word "obey" here is made up from two words <u>under</u> and <u>listen</u>.

2. Honor your Father and Mother.

- We are called to honor, no matter what our age is.
- How we honor will look different for each of us.
- We may have to <u>honor Jesus over</u> our parents at times.

3. Fathers be the number one <u>influencer for God</u> in your home.

- The idea here: Be both gentle and frim in our instruction.
- Treat your faith different from entertainment. Bad ? = "Did you like it?"
- You can stack the deck and still get a wild card.
