1. The People: the Pharisees

- The term Pharisees means <u>"separatists"</u>.
- The Pharisees were, to some extent, <u>well-meaning</u> people.
- How can a man be <u>right with God</u>? Job 25:4, Num. 25

2. The Pharisee's problem: passion perverted

- Hypocrisy and a desire to impress others. Luke 12:1, Matt. 23:5-12
- A <u>disdain</u> for "sinners". Matt. 9:11, Matt. 23:13
- Majoring on minors. Luke 6:1-12, Matt. 23:16-24
- Extra-biblical rules. Mark 7:1-8
- Looking down on others. Luke 18:9-14

3. Our Purpose: focus on Christ's righteousness NOT our own

- We must first and foremost <u>put on love</u>. Col. 3:14
- True love is never <u>void of truth.</u> Eph. 4:15
- Be <u>realistic</u> about your self-righteousness; it really is <u>insufficient</u>. Is. 64:6

Application:

- 1) Admit that you take <u>pleasure in comparing</u> yourself to <u>people you believe are less...</u>
- 2) Stop doing the job of the Holy Spirit.
- 3) Put on an attitude of <u>humility = gratitude</u>.
