The Unforgiving Servant

Pastor Mark Wilks, MATTHEW 18:21-35

Revenge is a <u>curse</u>! Jesus Christ is calling his disciples to <u>reverse</u> the <u>curse</u>!

1. The <u>lies</u> about forgiveness.

- The bible teaches revenge is OK (lie). Gen. 4:23, Deut. 32:35, Rom. 12:19
- Forgiveness is just a switch you flip (lie). Mt. 18:21
- There are limitations to forgiveness (lie). Mt. 18:22
- Whether I forgive or not is <u>no big deal (lie)</u>. Mt. 18:24

2. The <u>truth</u> about forgiveness.

- Forgiveness involves <u>anger</u> and recognition of the <u>debt</u>. vs 25
- Forgiveness begins with compassion. Mt. 18:27
- God's motivation and actions are inseparable. Mt. 18:2

3. The truth about <u>unforgiveness</u>.

• The first man had been forgiven 60 million denarii and cannot forgive 100 denarii.

We cannot embrace God's forgiveness if we are so busy clinging to past <u>wounds</u> and nursing old <u>grudges</u>. T. D. Jakes

- Unforgiveness hurts me and others. Mt. 18:31
- Unforgiveness does not go unnoticed by God. Mt. 18:32
- Unforgiveness will lead to chastisement from God. Mt. 18:34, Heb. 12:10
- You cannot hold fast to an <u>unforgiving spirit</u> and the <u>Holy Spirit</u> at the same time.

The state of your heart dictates whether you harbor a grudge or give grace, seek self-pity or seek Christ, drink human misery or taste God's mercy. Max Lucado

Application: Steps we can take toward forgiveness.

- 1) Look in the mirror and see God's grace over your sin.
- 2) Look with compassion upon those who sin against you.
- 3) Pray for those you need to forgive.
- 4) Surrender to the Lord and ask for <u>help in granting</u> forgiveness.
