#### 1. The King and His mission.

- The kingdom of God <u>ruled from heaven</u>.
- The word "good" indicates <u>careful choice</u> of the right seed for his purpose. Leon Morris
- The field is the world; but notice it is His field.
- Jesus refers to Himself as the Son of Man a Messianic title. Dan. 7:13-14

## 2. The King and His enemy.

- Specifically, he is Christ's <u>enemy</u>, attempting to <u>thwart</u> Christ's work.
- This enemy attacks when <u>nobody is watching</u>.
- The enemy's schemes are <u>deceptive</u>. 2 Cor. 11:13–15, 2 Thess. 2:9–12

### 3. The King and His strategy.

- "God has a right to take risks: it's his world." William Willimon
- Hell is depicted as burning resulting in weeping (emotional pain) and gnashing of teeth (physical pain).
- Angels are called to bring judgement. Christians are called to <u>influence</u>.
